3 DAY STRIKE IN RRBs Extend support

Workmen and Officers of RRBs have been on relentless struggle demanding Pay & Pension parity with the sponsor Banks, Compassionate Recruitment, Minimum Wages to casual employees pending their regularization, scrapping of the Mitra Committee on HR issues (akin to the Khandelwal Committee in respect of sponsor Banks) and opposing Government's various initiatives and machinations designed at privatization of RRBs. Despite repeated assurances from the managements of RRBs and the Government of India as also a series of Orders of various High Courts and even of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, Pay and Pension parity still remain distant dreams for the Workmen and Officers of RRBs. "UNITED FORUM OF RRB UNIONS" (UFRRBU).
