Following tasks that were taken up in the Central Committee meeting of Chennai are to be accomplished within the month of November this year. Therefore, units are earnestly requested to gear up the activities for doing the same.

List of Issues

We are in receipt of issues/suggestions only from 4 units. We reiterate if, for any reason whatsoever, a unit is not in a position to send any suggestion/issue, please inform us about the same so that the headquarters will not wait for that unit for preparing the list of issues.

Union Bank Centenary Day

It was decided that the Bank's Centenary will be observed through holding of mass meeting by all the Units on 11th November 2018 (Sunday) as "Union Bank Centenary Day". In the meeting, Federation's demand for centenary gift, "Absorption of all casual & temporary employees into permanent employment of the Bank as a one-time measure" has to be highlighted and, therefore, it is advisable for the units to mobilise casual/temporary employees en mass or in representative basis to the mass meeting. The meeting will also remember the glorious history of the Bank and its employees' movement and obviously will look forward their glorious future. As per decision, the Federation will bring out a memoir in the form of a booklet on the Bank and its employees' movement. To prepare and finalise the booklet a team comprising Com. V.R. Nair, Com. N.K. Shome, Com. C.J. Nandkumar, Com. M.V. Madhav Rao and Com. P.K. Sarangi was formed. It is hoped that the team will make a serious effort to bring out the memoir on the Centenary Day.

On the basis of opinion sought from all the Central Committee Members, Woman Sub-Committee Members and Permanent Invitees **a badge wearing programme on the programme for Union Bank Centenary Day will be observed on 9th November 2018.** Badges will be supplied by the headquarters. Due to festive season the printing job is getting delayed. As soon as we receive the badges we shall send them to the units.

Month Long Campaign Programme on Recruitment

There is inadequate recruitment in clerical cadre and no recruitment in subordinate staff cadre. In more than 50% of the branches all over India there is not a single permanent subordinate staff. Looking into the gravity of the issue a programme of month long campaign agitation from 1st November to 30th November 2018 has been taken up by the Federation. During the campaign, apart from demanding adequate recruitment in clerical and subordinate staff cadre, employees are to be informed as to how the Management and its recognized union (AIUBEA) have been working in tandem for inadequate recruitment in clerical cadre and absolutely no recruitment in subordinate staff cadre. The campaign agitation has to be implemented through displaying of posters in local language, issuing of leaflet in local language, holding of centralized meeting as well as cluster wise meetings.
