OBSERVE BLACK DAY ON 9TH SEPTEMBER 2019

In the CEB meeting held in Hyderabad on 1st September 2019 some important decisions were taken including two set of agitation programme on Management's reluctance in discussing with our Federation on employees' issues and on the announcement on merger of PSB made by the Finance Minister. Very soon we are releasing the Circular in detail on them. Since, in the meantime, on 9th September 2019 the Bank's Board is meeting for adopting the proposal as dictated by the Government of India for merger of Andhra Bank, Corporation Bank and Union Bank of India the day will remain as BLACK DAY and our Bank will unfortunately be remembered as instrumental to the demise of Andhra Bank and Corporation Bank.

Looking into the above, the undersigned discussed the matter with the President and available CC and CEB members in the headquarters from which it has been decided by the Federation to observe 9th September 2019 as the BLACK Day. Accordingly, we call upon all our members and well wishers to implement the following programme on 9th September (Monday) with utmost sincerity:

- ✦ Wearing of black badge
- ✦ Centralised Demonstration (by massive participation) before the Zonal and Regional Offices

We hope that other organisations of workman and officers (whether a constituent of UFBU or not) will also register their protest on the day of Board meeting.
